

Aiming for employees' ultimate self-realization with “Borderless” Notice of Headquarters Relocation

NOK Corporation (Head office: 1-12-15 Shibadaimon, Minato-ku, Tokyo) is pleased to announce the completion of its new headquarters building, which was previously relocated to Mita, Minato-ku due to the rebuilding of the former "Showa Building". We start operation in the new headquarters building from Tuesday, November 24.

The concept of our new headquarters building is "Borderless", eliminating all boundaries between departments and jobs and practicing our management spirit that "respects human dignity". Our goal is to create the "ultimate place of self-realization" where each and every employee can have a dream and pursuit it.



Achieve both Economy & Comfort

The new headquarters building is a seismically isolated building with eight stories above ground and a one-story basement. It is a six-minute walk from the north exit of JR Hamamatsucho Station. The exterior walls are glazed on three sides, maximizing the space efficiency of the office space and making the entire space look larger within the limited site constraints of an urban area. The window glass is made of glass eaves to prevent direct summer sunshine, and in addition, climber blinds that rise and fall from the bottom to the top are used to capture light effectively. The natural lighting is utilized to achieve economy and comfort at the same time.

Aim for an Urban Energy-Efficient Office

In addition to natural lighting, natural ventilation, rainwater and reclaimed water, and other natural energy sources are actively incorporated. A radiant air conditioning system is also introduced to eliminate wind flow. A number of state-of-the-art energy-efficient systems are incorporated to create an environmentally friendly urban energy-efficient office. It is expected to save about 50% of energy compared to the former headquarters building.

Furthermore, as a disaster response, the building is equipped with a two-line power receiving system and a private power generator to secure power for a certain period of time. Some floors are designed to serve as an evacuation shelter for stranded people in the event of a disaster.

Employees are also provided with no-territorial office as well as discussion areas and café-inspired spaces in various locations. We have developed a new environment that breaks down traditional barriers, deepens communication and allows us to work with new ideas.



As globalization continues to progress, we will continue to raise the awareness of our employees at the center of our domestic and overseas offices, strengthen our business foundation, and strive to grow as a company that can contribute to society as we work toward our 100th anniversary in 2041.
